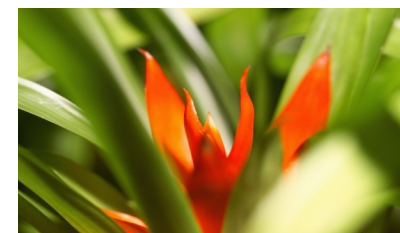

Adult Day & Alzheimer's Respite Programs- Health and Social Services for the Elderly

Who needs Adult Day and Respite services?

The Adult Day and Alzheimer's Respite services are community based and designed to provide social and related supportive services to persons 60 years of age and older. These services are designed to solve some difficulties of daily living while staying in the mainstream of community life.

Eligibility:

- Physically disabled or frail
- Need care during part of the day
- Experiencing mental confusion
- Likely to benefit from the individualized attention and social structure
- Any age with a diagnosis of Alzheimer's or related dementia disease

Adult Day Services Programs

A specialized plan of care is prepared for each individual depending on his or her needs and type of day care (social or health model) attending. The plan may include, but is not limited to:

- Cultural Activities
- Counseling
- Exercise programs
- Health Screenings
- Nutritional Needs
- Medical and Social Evaluations
- Recreation
- Community Outings
- Social Opportunities
- Therapy
- And much more!
